



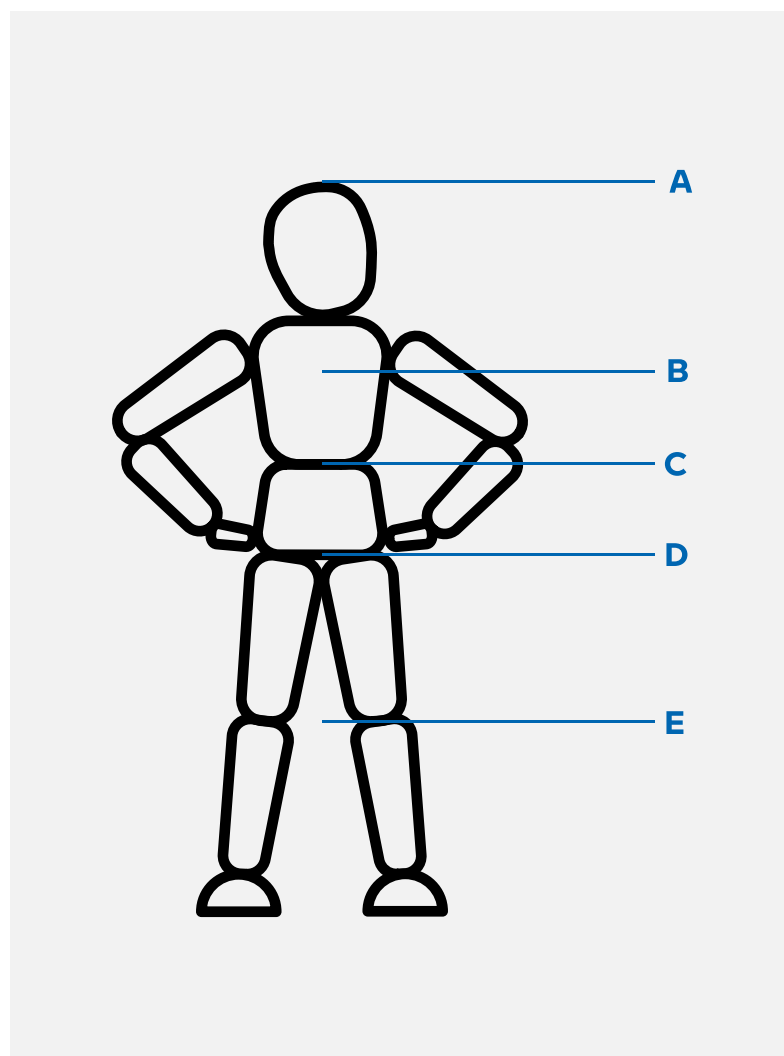
How to work out your size (Size Guide)

It is very important that the fit of your motorcycle suit is perfect. Too tight or too loose can affect your concentration and while embarking on your adventures you need minimal distraction as this could affect your safety on the road.

Jacket and trouser combinations must also sit right on your body in the riding position. The cut of the sleeves and legs should not ride up, not only is this a safety issue, but it also means you are not fully protected from the elements.

All BMW Motorrad suits are ergonomically designed with the seated position of the rider in mind. We integrate functional details for optimum comfort and breathability to make sure they are a perfect fit. We know that riders come in many different body shapes, so our suits are available in over 40 different sizes.

To find the one that is right for you, grab your tape measure and follow these simple instructions:



A

Height

Stand barefoot beside a door frame. Place a book on your head, hold it in position. Mark the position of the book on the door frame and measure from the floor.

B

Chest

Take this measurement while wearing a shirt or lightweight pullover. Pass the tape measure under your arms and measure around the broadest part of your chest and over the shoulder blades.

C

Waist

Measure around your shirt, just above the top of your trousers. Stand in a neutral position and don't hold in your stomach – that way you'll ensure the pants sit comfortably.

D

Hips

Measure around your body, at the widest point of your hips.

E

Inner leg

Measure the distance down the inside of your leg, from the crotch seam of your trousers to the sole of your foot.

For optimum accuracy it is recommended that someone else takes your measurements. This ensures that you maintain neutral positions and get the correct measurements.

Helmet size

The helmet is the most important part of your protective gear. For optimal safety, the helmet must fit properly. The allocation of helmet sizes to international sizes may vary.

This is how you can measure your size:

1. Take your tape measure and measure your head circumference horizontally at the widest part of your head (approx. 2.5 cm above the eyebrows).
2. Choose the helmet size that is closest to your measurement. If your measurement is between two helmet sizes, try the smaller helmet size first.
